Proposal Writing for Reserach Grants (ProGRANT)

- Target group: Young researchers (Africa, Middle East, Latin America, Southeast Asia)
- Content: Training for successful procurement of external funds
- Set-Up: Two one-week-presence phases with an online-coaching-phase in between (approx. 4 months) developing proposal writing skills and designing, writing and budgeting a promising proposal for research funding
- Partner: University of Cologne with regional partner universities
- Time frame: Annual call in quarter III

Targeted - practice oriented - cross-cultural dialogue

Online Course for Doctoral Supervisors at african universities

- Target group: PhD holders with (co-)supervision functions from Africa
- Content: state of doctoral studies in Africa, roles and responsibilities of the supervisor and the student, the supervision process
- Set-Up: six online modules (eight weeks), followed by a practical assignment; workload: nine hours /week plus ca. 15 hours on the final assignment.
- Partner: University of Stellenbosch
- Time frame: annual Call

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Targeted - practice oriented - cross-cultural dialogue

TrainIQA

- Target group: Quality Assurance Officers from HEIs (3 cohorts: Anglophone and Francophone Africa, Southeast Asia)
- Content: Internal Quality Assurance, Designing Effective QA Systems, Tools and Procedures, Teaching and Learning, Information Management, Curriculum Development, Linkages to External Quality Assurance, Project Management, Individual Reform Projects (PAP)
- Set-Up: Three presence phases, starting and ending in the region, middle workshop in Germany, one Kick-Off Meeting and Final Conference each involving the University leadership; project work in between the workshops
- Partner:
 - University of Potsdam, Centre for Quality Development Time frame: First cohort (Southeast Asia) starting in September 2020 (call appr. Middle of 2020)

Second cohort (Southern Africa) starting December 2020 (call appr. Autumn 2020)

Third cohort (Francophone Africa) starting beginning of 2021

New call 2021/22

- Target group: higher education managers who have not yet participated in a DIES training activity
- Who can apply: Training committees (50% DIES alumni)
- Topics: the topics are supposed to be in accordance with the DIES training courses

- Set-up: praxis-oriented; modular
- Time frame: September 2021 –
 September 2022, tbc
- Funding: tba

In 2019/20: 10,000 - 25,000 Euros, at least 10% third-party-contribution
